**DESCRIPTION OF ITEM:**

One Stanley Bailey No. 5C "Jack" plane manufactured between approximately 1910 and 1918. The plane bed is marked with Bailey at the toe and three patent dates MAR-25-02, AUG-19-02, APR-19-10 behind the frog and retains approximately 95% of its japanning. The iron is marked with the "V" trademark stamp dating to this same period. There is no visible damage (cracks, chips or repairs) to the metal body casting. The sole is very clean and the cheeks have a medium gray patina from age. There is no visible rust or evidence of rust damage. The rosewood knob and tote have all of their original finish with dents and scratches and no visible cracks or repairs.

The identification and condition of this item was obtained from photographic inspection.
